Design & Space Planning Updates

- Updated schematic designs to better align with our Patient Care Expansion Project budget were shared at the September 4 Leadership Meeting. Ask your Director about changes and timing.
- Mangum Construction, based in Clarkston, WA, has started building renovations
 for alarm, elevator and HVAC systems at the former Columbia Bank building. This
 will support a November 1 move-in date for teams including Health Information
 Management, Patient Financial Services, Revenue Integrity, Referrals and
 Authorizations. The Space and People committee are recommending the building
 and collection of activities are referred to as the Patient Accounts Building to help
 patients find the newly located services.
- Led by Karly Port, the "Space and People" committee is also working to address short and long-term movements during the construction period:
 - Care Coordination will have office space in the Patient Accounts Building while maintaining an office in the hospital to continue to serve all departments within the hospital.
 - The nutrition team will be locating to the second floor of the Patient Accounts Building but will continue to see patients at the hospital and in designated space at Corporate Pointe for outpatient appointments.
