

Pullman Regional has a network of clinics, including Palouse Pediatrics, which has an office in Moscow, Idaho. To practice in the State of Idaho, you'll also need to apply for your Idaho State medical license.

Life On the Palouse

Welcome to the heart of the Palouse, one of the most beautiful places in the Pacific Northwest!

Pullman, Washington is a vibrant community located in the Palouse region of eastern Washington. Home to Washington State University (WSU) and 8 miles west of the University of Idaho in Moscow, Idaho, Pullman offers big-city amenities coupled with small town charm.

With 34,000 people, Pullman is known for low crime rates, the place to raise a family, and a continual source of innovation influenced by WSU's flagship campus. Hiking, fishing, biking, snowshoeing, golfing and fostering a love for the outdoors is a natural draw for many tourists and enjoyed all year long by locals.

Residents enjoy excellent schools, safe neighborhoods, Pac-12 sporting events, a downtown filled with locally-owned businesses, and a plethora of outdoor activities including hiking, biking, fishing, hunting, camping, and water sports on the nearby Snake River.

Familiar shopping and dining options include Starbucks, Chipotle, Target, Walmart, Safeway, Marshall's, and a variety of retail options at the Palouse Mall in Moscow, Idaho.

WEATHER

Pullman has four distinct seasons with 172 days of sunshine. Average seasonal temperatures:

July: 82 degrees

October: 60 degrees

January: 36 degrees

April: 56 degrees

GETTING HERE

Travel to and from Pullman is easy through the Pullman-Moscow Regional Airport with daily flights to Seattle and Boise. Lewiston (34 miles away) offers daily flights to Salt Lake City and Denver, and Spokane International Airport (80 miles away) boasts flights to 20 non-stop destinations including Atlanta, Denver, Salt Lake City, Los Angeles, Phoenix, and Chicago.

K-12 EDUCATION

School-aged children in our community have options including Pullman School District and the Montessori School of Pullman. The Pullman School District averages 2,819 students and are served by 160 teachers with an average of 12 years of experience; 70% of teachers hold Master's degrees.

HIGHER EDUCATION

WSU is a land-grant university founded in 1890 in Pullman, WA. Today campuses are also in Spokane, Tri-Cities, Vancouver, Everett, and a Global Campus (online). WSU offers 101 majors, 79 master's degree programs, 65 doctoral degree programs and 3 professional degree programs in medicine, pharmacy, and veterinary medicine. WSU is a member of the Pac-12 Conference and treats sports fans to swimming, football, basketball, volleyball, baseball, track and field, soccer, golf, rowing, and tennis.

Pullman Regional Practice Profiles

Pullman Regional Hospital is a critical access, independent, not-for-profit public hospital district. Situated 8 miles from the Idaho border, our hospital and network of clinics serve Washington and Idaho residents, students, faculty, and game day fans of Washington State University (a Pac-12 university) and the University of Idaho (a Big Sky university). Once a staple on the WSU campus as Pullman Memorial Hospital, we found a new home in 2004 on Bishop Blvd. with room to build a state-of-the-art 95,000 square foot facility. The building is home to our inpatient, outpatient, and emergency care services plus a variety of independent medical practices.

Our clinics include: cardiology, family and internal medicine, pediatrics, podiatry, interventional pain management, psychiatry & behavioral health, sleep medicine, urology, and surgery/endoscopy. We partner with Inland Orthopaedic Surgery & Sports Medicine Clinic to provide orthopedic and sports medicine care to the community. We also are a part of Palouse Specialty Physicians - our partnership with area hospitals Gritman Medical Center and Whitman Hospital & Medical Center is a joint effort to provide specialized health care services and clinicians to our region. Together we support ENT, Audiology, Neurology and Oncology.

FAMILY MEDICINE RESIDENCY CENTER

The Family Medicine Residency Center is a full-service primary care clinic located on the hospital campus. The Center is part of the Family Medicine Residency Program, a partnership between Pullman Regional and the Washington State University Elson S. Floyd College of Medicine. Patients are seen by resident physicians and attending physicians.

Patients can feel supported through longer appointment times, chronic disease management for things like diabetes, hypertension, obesity, and COPD, comprehensive obstetrics and women's health care, preventative care, pediatrics, and sports medicine.

Exam rooms: 15 | Average monthly visits: 400

PALOUSE HEART CENTER

Palouse Heart Center, located inside Pullman Regional Hospital, has a board-certified cardiologist and American College of Cardiology Fellow to provide cardiology care to the region. Patients with pacemakers, heart failure, coronary heart disease, implants, and other cardiac ailments can receive care, support, and procedures through this clinic.

Exam rooms: 4 | Average monthly visits: 350

PALOUSE HEALTH CENTER

Palouse Health Center provides primary care services to Palouse, WA (a 25 minute drive from Pullman Regional Hospital). Patients can seek services like sports physicals, wellness exams, medication management, and chronic disease management through this clinic, as well as in-office procedures and laboratory services.

Exam rooms: 4 | Average monthly visits: 150

PALOUSE MEDICAL

Palouse Medical is a full-service primary care clinic, located on the hospital campus. Palouse Medical offers both Family and Internal Medicine services and care services through ReadyCare. Patients can feel supported with care for chronic conditions, wellness exams, obstetrics, sports physicals, medication management, and in-office procedures.

Exam rooms: 24 | Average monthly visits: 1,800

PALOUSE PEDIATRICS

Palouse Pediatrics is the region's only pediatric practice- with locations in Pullman, WA and Moscow, ID. Patients are seen by board-certified pediatricians for well child visits, in-office procedures, immunizations, sports physicals, and medication management. Patients can also feel supported by a pediatrician on-call 24 hours a day.

Exam rooms: 6 (per location) | Average monthly visits: 1.400

PALOUSE PSYCHIATRY & BEHAVIORAL HEALTH

Palouse Psychiatry & Behavioral Health, located inside Pullman Regional Hospital, provides mental health services with a focus on psychiatric evaluations and treatment for all ages. Patients can be seen for a variety of conditions including depression, anxiety, eating disorders, neuropsychology, obsessive-compulsive disorder and more. The practice is guided by collaboration and coordination of services with patient and referral sources, including physicians and other mental health/community agencies.

Exam rooms: Consult room for each provider

Average monthly visits: 460

PALOUSE SLEEP MEDICINE

Palouse Sleep Medicine, located inside Pullman Regional Hospital, can help patients with a variety of sleep conditions including sleep apnea, restless leg syndrome, insomnia, narcolepsy and more. The Sleep Center Lab, located in Pullman Regional Hospital, is nationally accredited with the American Academy of Sleep Medicine, overseen by a board-certified sleep medicine physician.

Exam rooms: 4 | Average monthly visits: 150

PALOUSE UROLOGY CENTER

Palouse Urology Center, located inside Pullman Regional Hospital, helps patients overcome common discomforts and conditions related to the urinary tract. Patients are seen by a board-certified urologist for conditions like kidney stones, bladder and kidney infections, erectile dysfunction, vasectomies, cancers, and more. Minimally-invasive and robotic-assisted surgery technologies utilized include da Vinci, Aquablation Therapy, Blue Light Cystoscopy with Cysview, and Urolift.

Exam rooms: 5 | Average monthly visits: 278

PULLMAN FAMILY MEDICINE

Pullman Family Medicine is a full-service primary care clinic located in north Pullman, close to the Washington State University campus. Patients can feel supported with care for chronic conditions, wellness exams, obstetrics, sports physicals, LGBTQIA+ inclusive services, medication management, and in-office procedures.

Exam rooms: 14 | Average monthly visits: 1,650

PULLMAN FOOT & ANKLE

Pullman Foot & Ankle, located inside Pullman Regional Hospital, provide podiatry support to the community through a doctor of podiatric medicine. Patients can receive care for a variety of foot problems including flatfeet, arthritis, ingrown toenails, sprains, strains, and fractures, gait abnormalities and more.

Exam rooms: 3 | Average monthly visits: 150

PULLMAN SURGICAL ASSOCIATES

Pullman Surgical Associates, located inside Pullman Regional Hospital, provides endoscopy, general and 24/7 emergency surgery coverage to the region. Two general surgeons, two emergency surgeons, a board-certified gastroenterologist, and a GI ARNP make up the skilled team. Minimally-invasive and robotic-assisted da Vinci surgery technology is utilized. Patients can receive surgical care for appendectomies, hernias, mastectomies, colectomies and a variety of other procedures, including endoscopies and GI care.

Exam rooms: 6 exam rooms, 5 operating rooms, 2 endoscopy suites | Average monthly visits: 550
